

HOW MUCH ARE HEALTHCARE ACQUIRED INFECTIONS (HAIS) COSTING YOUR FACILITY?

Healthcare-Aquired Infections (HAIs) are becoming increasingly common. Due to an increase in invasive procedures and a growing resistance to antibiotics. HAIs have increased by 36% in the last 20 years. The human cost is over **99,000 deaths per year**, which represent a 5% death rate for HAIs. On average **HAIs add an additional 8 days in the ICU and increases hospital stays for 9 days**.

HOW MUCH DOES THAT MEAN FOR YOUR FACILITY?

HAIs in hospitals alone result in an estimated \$28-\$33 billion in excess medical costs every year. That is an estimated cost of up to \$32,000 per licensed bed in the U.S. For an average 180 bed facility, that equals an additional \$5,760,000 in direct cost. Under the new Affordable Care Act (ACA), Hospitals will lose reimbursement based on a criteria that is heavily weighted on HAIs and patient satisfaction.
